## SHERRY SHEPHERD SARGENT SCHOLARSHIP

### 2020-2021 School Year

**Purpose:** To provide an academic scholarship to a deserving Cherry Creek School District High School Senior student to further his/her academic aspirations.

Award Components: One (1) \$2,000.

#### Criteria:

- 1. Applicant must: (1) Be a senior high school student attending one of the Cherry Creek School District high schools, (2) Be expected to graduate following the spring semester in the year of the awarded scholarship, and (3) Have either been accepted to or applied to an accredited university or college. (The scholarship will only be awarded to a student accepted by and attending an accredited university or college.)
- 2. In an effort to make higher education opportunities available to as many students as possible, this scholarship will not be awarded to a student who has been offered or accepted a full ride scholarship to attend a public, private, or service institution.
- 3. Applicant must demonstrate a commitment to education through a minimum grade point average of 3.0 out of a 4.0 (unweighted). In selecting the recipient of this scholarship, the student's academic, community service, and financial need will be considered by the committee.
- 4. Upon acceptance, the applicant must provide the following information: name of the accepting college/university, student ID #, to whom the check should be made out, an address where the check should be sent, phone number and email address. The scholarship recipient must also inform Dr. Sargent about the results of each college freshman grading period and how he/she is doing in general.
- 5. The application must be emailed to PINccsd@gmail.com by Monday, March 1, 2021.
- 6. Finalists will be notified by Friday, March 12. Finalists must be available for online interviews which will be held Wednesday March 31 between 2:30 and 6:00pm. All finalists will be notified of their status by Friday, April 9.

## **Application Process:**

- 1. **Complete the application form.** This should be done by providing answers to each section in a separate document that you then email to us. Handwritten and/or incomplete applications <u>will not</u> be processed. - 2. Along with your application please submit:
  - One letter of recommendation from a high school teacher, counselor, administrator, or principal.
  - Your current high school transcript.
