Invest in Success Gala-Forward Together-March 11, 2021

Our annual gala attracts 600 community and district leaders and corporate partners. Classroom Grants

The Foundation's signature program awards educators micro grants of up to \$1,000 to creatively solve a problem, find new uses for technology or implement innovation in the classroom. Last year, we awarded over \$100,000 in grants across the district. We are in the process of reimagining our grants due to COVID-19 and expect our next grant cycle to be in fall 2021.

Partners in Action/Pathways of Purpose

This is a new Foundation initiative to connect our corporate champions to our students, educators and district leadership. We know that the combination of industry and education creates opportunities for our students and allows our corporate partners to share expertise and introduce our students to opportunities post-graduation. Examples include but are not limited to, guest lecturing, job shadowing, advisory boards, internships and apprenticeships. The Foundation will work closely with each corporate champion to develop unique vehicles for engagement.
